



ZULAL VOSKEHAT 2019

Meaning pure in Armenian, Zujal was founded to craft wines that express the purest characteristics of Armenian indigenous grape varieties. With its Classic collection, Zujal focuses on Armenia's signature Areni and Voskehat grapes.

GRAPE HISTORY

100% Voskehat. Translating as "golden berry Voskehat is a late-ripening thick-skinned ancient grape variety. It is widespread in Aragatsotn, Armavir and Vayots Dzor.

Voskehat is known for its complex stone fruity aromas and has been used for a wide range of wine types including dry white, sparkling, as well as dessert and fortified wines.

VINEYARDS

South facing single plot with volcanic soil situated at 1400 masl in Aghavnadzor, Vayots Dzor region.

VINIFICATION

Hand harvested and hand sorted, fermented in stainless steel.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Pale golden yellow in color, Zujal Voskehat stands out with aromas of tropical and stone fruits. The wine is crisp with complex layers of ripe fruit and flowers. The finish is long with a pleasing minerality.
